better .eps previews

If you're not happy with the low-res proxy preview that comes built into an imported .eps file, use InDesign's import options to generate a better one.

If the low-res preview image saved into your EPS file isn't all you'd like or need it to be, check the **Show Import Options** box in the Place dialog box.

In the **EPS Import Options** dialog box, check the **Rasterize the PostScript** radio button. This tells InDesign to ignore the canned low-res preview image and generate a new preview image from the PostScript data in the EPS file.
